Bromont Trail Network Code of Ethics and Safety

-  Respect the fauna and flora, be discreet and don't leave anything behind.
-  Stay on the trails, bring back your trash, and don't make any fires.
-  Respect the signs and routes: check if you can use the trails for your sport and be grateful for the access granted by the neighbouring landowners by keeping your voices down and by being quiet.
-  Don't take the closed trails of the Parc des Sommets and discourage any diehards from using them in order to preserve the trails and facilitate the work of Les Amis des Sentiers.
-  Stay in the middle of the trails to avoid widening them.
-  The trails are shared and are often multifunctional: meet and pass others carefully and courteously.
-  Enjoy the Parc des Sommets from sunrise to sunset.
-  Check the weather and trail conditions before you head out.
-  If the ground gives way, walk away!

- Keep your dog on a leash at all times for everyone's safety, and pick up their droppings;
- Yield the way for passing horses.

- Don't go on the trails after a downpour;
- Control your bicycle and respect your limits;
- Yield the way for hikers and horses;
- Always wear a helmet;
- Don't alter or modify the trails;
- Slow down when you meet a rider and make sure they've spotted you.

- Don't leave your horse's dung on the trails;
- Do not allow your horse to graze along the edge of the trail.
